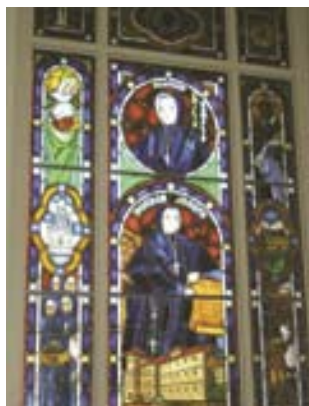

Stained-glass images of the foundresses of the Sisters of Providence – Blessed Emilie Gamelin in Montreal in 1843 and Mother Joseph of the Sacred Heart in the West in 1856 -- were installed at St. Joseph Parish in Yakima in November. The vivid, brilliantly colored stained glass for the window was handblown in France. Anacortes-area artist Robert Hill deepened the color in his Hillhouse Studio on Guemes Island. Mr. Hill, a Catholic, called the work “a labor of love.” ●

# Rest in Peace

## Mary Audrey McCoy, SP (Annabelle Juliette McCoy)

Sister Mary Audrey McCoy (aka Annabelle Juliette McCoy), age 82, died January 26 at St. Joseph Residence in Seattle. She had been a Sister of Providence for 62 years.



She was born June 17, 1923, in Spokane to Jessie and Frances (Larchey) McCoy. She had five sisters: Theresa, Frances, Thelma, Evelyn and Audrey and one brother, Jackie, all of whom preceded her in death.

Sister Mary Audrey entered the novitiate of the Sisters of Providence in Seattle in 1944. She professed first vows in 1945 and final vows in 1948. Her first assignment was at St. Michael School, Olympia (1945-47). Then she was a helper in the dietary department at Mount St. Vincent, Seattle (1947-50), and at Saint Joseph Academy, Yakima (1950-52). For the next seven years she taught at various times at Holy Family School, Seattle; Providence Academy, Vancouver; St. Finbar School, Burbank; St. Michael School, Olympia; and Sacred Heart School, Tacoma.

She received her bachelor's degree from the University of Portland in 1964 and a master's degree in library science in 1967. She served as a librarian at St. Joseph Academy, Yakima, and at Bellevue Public Library (1967-70). Other ministries included refectory supervisor and nurse's aide. She found her true calling in ministry as a home chore aide in Seattle's Central Area, visiting the low-income elderly and helping them remain independent.

In 1990, Sister Mary Audrey retired to St. Joseph Residence, Seattle. Survivors

include nephew Pat and wife Marsha Moriarty, Chicago; nephew, Kevin and wife Cathy Moriarty; nephew Steve and wife Leslie Moriarty; niece Kathleen and husband Michael Lovejoy; niece Theresa and husband Jim Anderson, Seattle; several cousins, her community of the Sisters of Providence, and many other friends.

Vigil Service was held January 30 and the Funeral Mass was celebrated January 31, both at St. Joseph Residence, West Seattle. ●

## Ellen Elizabeth Kelly, SP (Emma Kelly)

Sister Ellen Elizabeth Kelly (aka Emma Theresa Kelly), age 93, died February 5 at St. Joseph Residence in Seattle. She had been a Sister of Providence for 71 years.



Born June 26, 1912, in Seattle to William J. and Theresa M. (Brinton) Kelly, she had two sisters, Theresa and Ellen, and three brothers, William, John and David.

Sister Ellen Elizabeth entered the novitiate of the Sisters of Providence in Seattle in 1935. She professed first vows in 1936 and final vows in 1939. She obtained her teaching diploma in 1931, and her bachelor's degree in education from Seattle University in 1944.

Her ministries included 25 years as teacher and principal in Providence elementary and secondary schools in Moxee City, Olympia, Seattle, Vancouver, Burbank, Walla Walla and Yakima. She was the founding principal at St. Finbar School in Burbank and was the superior at St. Joseph Academy in Yakima (1953-59). Sister Ellen Elizabeth spent many years in development work in various locations including Providence Heights, Issaquah (1962-1973), and Providence High School, Burbank (1973-79; 1986-89). In 1968 she became provincial councilor,

director of community services. In 1979, she worked at corporate headquarters in Seattle in development and was community services assistant in Provincial Administration until 1986. She retired in 1990, but she continued to write chronicles for Providence High School, Burbank. In recent years, she moved to St. Joseph Residence, Seattle.

In work, in art, in travel and in community, she built and fostered a multitude of relationships which continued to enrich her throughout her life.

Sister Ellen Elizabeth is survived by nieces Nancy Benham, Bellevue; Colleen Clancey and husband Alex; Teri Kelly Stackpole, Seattle; and Patricia O'Sullivan, San Jose; nephews Wally and wife Karlen Clausen, Auburn, WA; Jack and wife Janice Kelly, Post Falls, Idaho; several cousins; her community of the Sisters of Providence, and many other friends.

Vigil Service was held February 10 and the Funeral Mass was celebrated February 11, both at St. Joseph Residence, West Seattle. ●

## Therese Leonie Beaupre, SP (Irene Beaupre)

Sister Therese Leonie Beaupre died February 12 at St. Joseph Residence in Seattle at the age of 92. She had been a Sister of Providence for 71 years.



She was born the fourth of nine children on July 8, 1913, in St. Hubert, Quebec, to Hilaire and Leonie (Desbiens) Beaupre. She attended the local Catholic school and graduated from high school. In 1934 she entered the novitiate of the Sisters of Providence at the Motherhouse in Montreal, Quebec. She professed her first vows in 1936 and final vows in 1939.

Shortly after her profession, Sister Therese Leonie was assigned to the former St. Ignatius Province in the western United States. She became a U.S. citizen in 1947. She attended the College of Great Falls, in Great Falls, Mont.

Her ministry assignments included: work in dietary at St. Thomas Home, Great Falls (1936-38); St. Joseph Academy, Sprague, WA (1939-41); Our Lady of Lourdes Academy, Wallace, Idaho, (1941-42); and Columbus Hospital, Great Falls (1942-66). She then worked in the sewing room at St. Patrick Hospital, Missoula, Mont., (1966-67) and became a patient visitor and worked in admissions and in the emergency room (1967-84). She worked in pastoral care (1984-88), then she retired in Missoula. Naturally outgoing and sociable, Sister Therese Leonie appreciated the opportunity to bring comfort and encouragement to patients and families.

She moved to Mount St. Joseph, Spokane, in 1990, then later moved to St. Joseph Residence, Seattle, in 1996. When she retired, she kept her sister-companions entertained with wonderful stories, many retracing earlier decades of the congregations' history as it was fleshed out in her life and in the lives of other sisters who have spent their energies for the good of others in the West.

She is survived by her sister, Sister Aimee Beaupre, SP, Montreal, Quebec; numerous nieces and nephews, the community of the Sisters of Providence, and many other friends.

Vigil Service was held February 15 and the Funeral Mass was celebrated February 16, both at St. Joseph Residence, West Seattle. ●

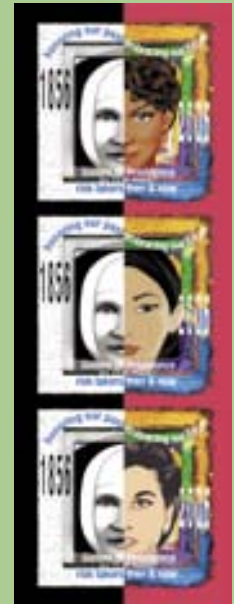
